- Sector 3 - OK Mini market and surrounding areas = 4.9 KM's
- Sector 4 - Mr. Katz and surrounding area = 6.8 KM's

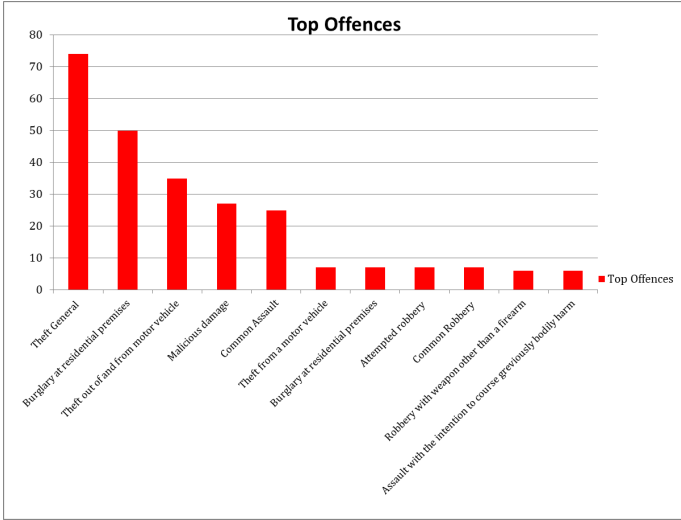
To inform Northpine can only afford 4 Public Safety Officers, and current compliment one dedicated vehicle in the area and one controller per shift.

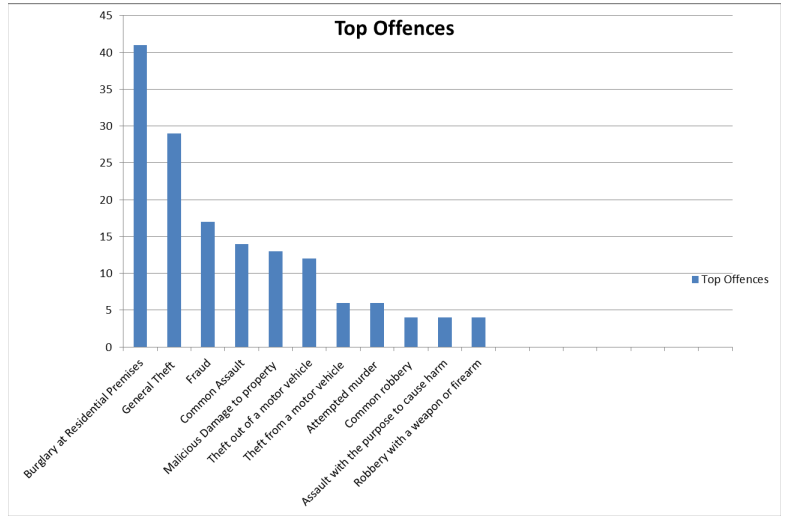
GENERAL SAFETY
